PRIVACY NOTICE

This privacy notice aims to inform you about the processing of your personal data in connection with the registration and visit of our event.

The data controller of your personal data processed by us is Active Ownership Corporation S.à r.l., 17, rue de Flaxweiler, L-6776 Grevenmacher, Luxembourg; e-mail: gdpr@activeownership.lu. You can reach our data protection officer at: +352 28800 120.

What personal data do we process? We process personal data such as your name, e-mail address, and information regarding existing food allergies or intolerances, provided by you when registering for the event.

How do we obtain your personal data? You provide it to us directly when registering for the event. This event can be photographed. The essential information can be found below. If you do not want to be photographed, you can inform the photographer directly.

For what purposes and on what legal basis is your data processed? The processing serves the purpose of preparing, carrying out, and following up on the event, including communicating with you. We base the processing of your personal data - unless explicitly stated otherwise in this privacy notice - on our legitimate interests (Article 6 (1) point (f) of the GDPR). The processing of your data serves the legitimate interest of carrying out the event to expand our business relationship and to inform you about possible investment opportunities that may be of interest to you. If processing of special categories of data such as health data (information on food allergies or intolerances) takes place, we will obtain your explicit consent for this processing (Article 9 (2) point (a) of the GDPR).

Who we share your personal data with: Your personal data is not transferred to recipients outside the European Economic Area.

How long we keep your personal data: Your personal data will only be stored for as long as is necessary to fulfil the purpose for which it was collected. Storage beyond this period is carried out, if necessary, due to legal retention periods (e.g. due to tax or commercial law requirements, which can stipulate a retention period of 6 or 10 years).

Your rights:

(1) Right to information and right to rectification: you have a right to information regarding your data processed by us. If your data is incorrect or incomplete, you may request that your data be corrected or completed;

(2) Right to erasure: you may, if the legal requirements are met, request that we erase your personal data without delay;

(3) Right to restriction of processing: you may, if the legal requirements are met, request that we restrict processing;

(4) Data portability: you have the right to receive personal data that you have provided to us and that we process for the performance of a contract or on the basis of consent, in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format. In this case, you may also request that we transfer this data directly to a third party, if technically feasible;

(5) Withdrawal of consent: If you have given us consent to process your data, you may withdraw this consent at any time without affecting the lawfulness of processing before its withdrawal;

(6) Right to lodge a complaint to the supervisory authorities: If you believe that the processing of your personal data infringes applicable law, you may lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority, in particular the supervisory authority in your place of residence, place of work or place of the alleged infringement.

Right to object (in the case of data processing based on legitimate interests): If we process your personal data on the basis of our legitimate interests, you may object to the processing on grounds relating to your particular situation. In this case, we will no longer process your personal data unless we can demonstrate compelling legitimate grounds for the processing which override your interests, rights and freedoms, or the processing serves to establish, exercise or defend legal claims.

We reserve the right to update this privacy notice at any time. In this case, we will inform you about the changes.
